Creating an account is required to submit an abstract. This requires at least one author to register for the Francophone Medical Biology Days (JFBM). Instructions for authors on preparing the abstract and poster are available on jfbm.fr.

Poster submission on site

After notification of the acceptance of the abstract, the poster is prepared using the A0 portrait template that you will receive after notification. The poster must be submitted in PDF format on the website jfbm.fr

The poster is printed in "paper format" by the JFBM organizing committee and will be displayed throughout the days.

Selection for the "180 Second Challenge"

The scientific committee selects around ten posters to participate in the "180 Second Challenge" session.

The authors will give an oral presentation of their work in 180 seconds, on Friday, October 10, 2025, from 12 p.m. to 1 p.m.

At the end of this session, four posters chosen by the scientific committee will be awarded a JFBM poster prize.

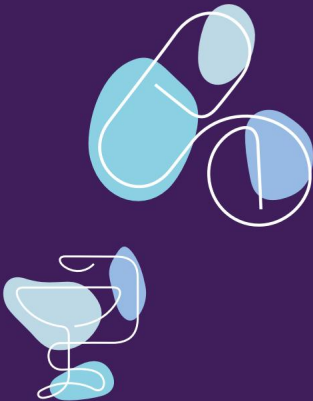

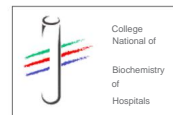

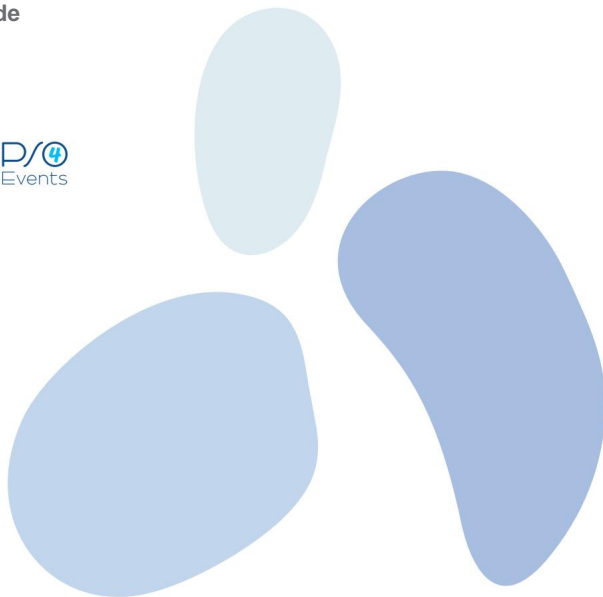
